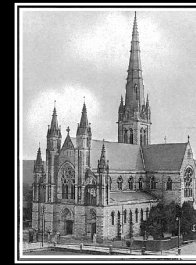

The **BROWN SCAPULAR OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL** will be blessed by Bishop Philip Boyce and distributed after Devotions tonight, Sunday 19th October at 7.30 pm in the Cathedral. Everyone is very welcome.



Fr. Michael Shields is a native born Alaskan priest ordained 34 years ago for the Archdiocese of Anchorage, Alaska and now lives and works in the Diocese of St. Joseph, Far East Siberia, Russia. He has been deeply inspired by Jesu Caritas, with a deep love for the Eucharist and especially Eucharistic Adoration under the inspiration of Blessed Charles De Foucauld.

In 1994 after a 40 day retreat, and a two year discernment, Fr. Michael began a life under the spirituality of Brother Charles in Magadan in Far East Siberia. He and some other priests formed a small brotherhood called the Brothers of the Heart of Jesus. The life included the call to "pray in the camps" and to serve the re-emerging Church by preaching the Gospel from the "roof top" of his life.

Fr. Michael supports many ministries in his parish and community including pro-life work with young women under pressure to have abortions, addiction recovery programmes, prison ministry and retreat work and is an Evangelist-at-Large on behalf of the pontifical charity Aid to the Church in Need.

Fr. Michael will celebrate the 7.30 pm Mass on Wednesday 22nd October in the Cathedral, followed by a talk and a Holy Hour. Everyone welcome.
