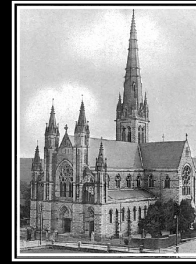

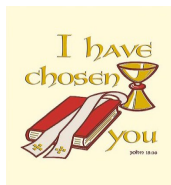

This afternoon, Sunday 28th June at 4 pm Rev. Brendan Ward from Edeninfagh, Glenties will be ordained a Priest.

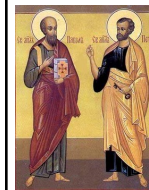
