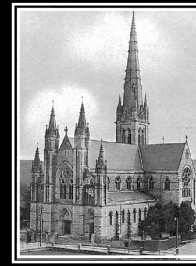

Matt Talbot (1856-1925) was a serious alcoholic from his early teens. He pawned everything to buy drink and even stole a fiddle from a blind fiddler to satisfy his thirst for drink. One Saturday morning he stood outside his local pub hoping that one of his friends would ask him in for a drink. But they all passed him by. That day he went to a Priest and took a pledge to stay off drink. Thus began one of the most remarkable stories of recovery from addiction and a life dedicated to God and Prayer.

In the build-up to the Feast of the Sacred Heart, we are holding a **NOVENA OF HOLY HOURS (8.30 pm - 9.30 pm)** in the Cathedral from June 4th - June 12th. During this time we will have artefacts associated with Matt Talbot in the Cathedral including his bible, wooden pillow and iron bed.

Each night we hope to have a speaker on some area of addiction/breaking addiction. We invite you to come see the artefacts during the day and to pray for and attend the Novena when hopefully our prayers will help others.
