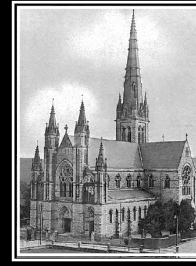

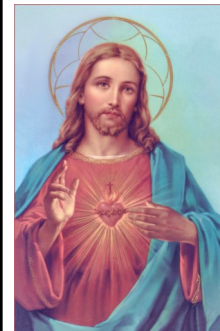
CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION
