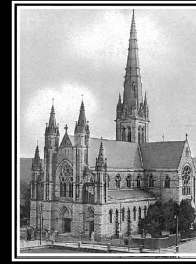

The **BROWN SCAPULAR OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL** will be blessed and distributed after Devotions tonight, Sunday 25th October at 7.30 pm in the Cathedral. Everyone is very welcome.



There seems to be a little confusion in relation to '**BOOKING MASSES**' in the Cathedral.

It is possible to book an 'Individual Mass' for your deceased loved ones/special intention etc. at 8 am and 10 am Mass, Monday to Friday (June to September) and 8 am, 10 am and 7.30 pm, Monday to Friday (October to May).

The Friday Evening Mass is a '**Mass for all whose anniversaries occur at this time**' and there is usually a number of names mentioned. When a 10 am Mass is booked, it is on the understanding that if a funeral should arise that we may have to change the 'Mass Intention' to another date or we can include the 'Intention' in the Prayer of the Faithful on the particular day. The 10 am Mass on a Saturday morning is reserved for a Month's Mind Mass or for a First Anniversary Mass. The recommended Diocesan Mass Stipend (Offering) is €10 per individual Mass.

People have asked what the ® means in the Newsletter opposite certain Masses. We **reserve** ® a number of Masses per week in case of a Funeral/ Month's Mind Mass or First Anniversary Mass. If there is a blank space opposite a certain Mass, this means it is available for a Mass Intention.
