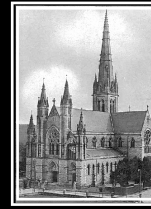

## ST. EUNAN'S CATHEDRAL LETTERKENNY NEWSLETTER

*Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time*



As the Jubilee Year of Mercy comes to an end, Holy Doors that have been opened will close around the world today. Bishop Philip Boyce will close the Holy Door of Mercy in St. Eunan's Cathedral at the 12 noon Mass. The Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica, Rome will close next Sunday on the Solemnity of Christ the King.

Lord Jesus Christ, you have taught us to be merciful like the heavenly Father, and have told us that whoever sees you sees Him. Show us your face and we will be saved. Your loving gaze freed Zacchaeus and Matthew from being enslaved by money, the adulteress and Magdalene from seeking happiness only in created things; made Peter weep after his betrayal, and assured Paradise to the repentant thief.

Let us hear, as if addressed to each one of us, the words that you spoke to the Samaritan woman: 'If you knew the gift of God!' You are the visible face of the invisible Father, of the God who manifests his power above all by forgiveness and mercy: let the church be your visible face in the world, its Lord risen and glorified. You willed that your ministers would also be clothed in weakness in order that they may feel compassion for those in ignorance and error: let everyone who approaches them feel sought after, loved, and forgiven by God.

Send your Spirit and consecrate every one of us with its anointing. Bring good news to the poor, proclaim liberty to captives and the oppressed, and restore sight to the blind. We ask this through the intercession of Mary, Mother of Mercy, you who live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit for ever and ever. Amen.
