LETTERKENNY MEMORIES will be held in the Station House Hotel on Monday 31st July at 8 pm. Light refreshment served. All are welcome.

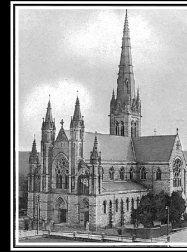

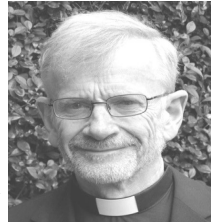
