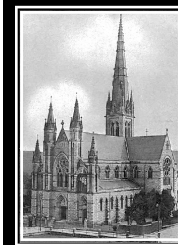

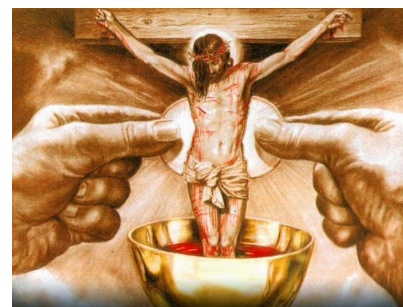


### PAPAL VISIT TO IRELAND
