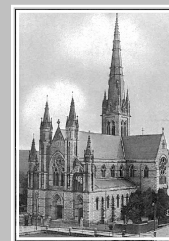

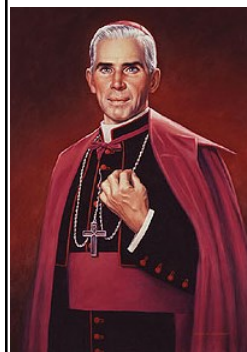

### **ARCHBISHOP FULTON J. SHEEN**

On **Tuesday 26th February at 7pm**, Monsignor Richard Soseman will



speak about the Servant of God **Fulton J. Sheen** at the Divine Mercy Centre (behind the Cathedral). Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen was renowned for his evangelising work, especially through the media, in the United States and beyond, from 1950s - 1970s. His many books lead many to a deeper faith, while his work in the Pontifical Mission Society supported the mission. His parents were both of Irish descent, from Roscommon, and he was no stranger to this country.

Because of the Holiness of Archbishop Sheen's life, his cause for Canonisation has made steady progress, and his Beatification is eagerly awaited.

Monsignor Richard Soseman is a priest of the Servant of God's native Diocese of Peoria, Illinois. and was the Promotor of his cause for Beatification. Until last year, an official of the Congregation for the Clergy at the Holy See, Monsignor Soseman is now a Pastor (Parish Priest) of his own Diocese of Peoria, Illinois. He promises to provide an inspirational and warming introduction to the life, works and sanctity of Archbishop Sheen. You will be most welcome to come and hear what he has to say.
