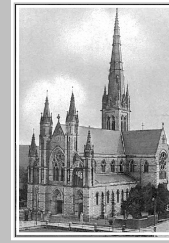
The **Irish Wheelchair Association CHURCH GATE COLLECTION** will take place on **13th/14th July**. Your support would be appreciated.
