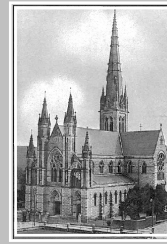

### **DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO KNOCK**

The annual Diocesan Pilgrimage to Knock will take place on **Saturday 17th August** (The Feast of Our Lady of Knock). Bishop Alan McGuckian will lead this Pilgrimage. We invite and encourage Parishioners to travel to Knock for this day. **Anointing of the Sick** takes place at **2.30 pm** in the Basilica with Mass at 3 pm. A bus will leave the Cathedral Car Park at 8.30 am. Tickets for the Pilgrimage are priced: €25 adults and €10 children, and may be purchased from the Parochial House up until 4 pm on Friday 16th August.

Parishioners are courteously reminded that **PARKING INSIDE THE CATHEDRAL RAILS** is intended for those with **limited mobility and the elderly**, especially on Sundays and Holy Days. Those who do park in this area are asked not to park beyond the parking bays along the side of the Cathedral leading to the two porches. Please do not obstruct the steps leading from the side doors and leave the passage between the steps and the gates clear. This is important both to allow parishioners to enter/exit safely and to ensure access to the Cathedral in case of emergency. Mass goers should also be attentive to the double yellow lines on the roads around the Cathedral, particularly on Cathedral Road and opposite the main gates of the Cathedral – responsible parking should take care not to impede traffic and take into consideration the passage of emergency vehicles at all times.
