St. Eunan's College CHURCH GATE COLLECTION will take place next weekend, 9th and 10th November. Your support would be appreciated.

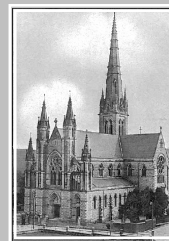
