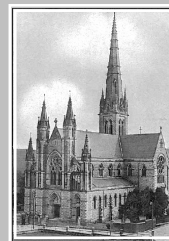

TALK AND MASS OF THANKSGIVING ON THE LIFE OF ST. JOHN HENRY NEWMAN

There will be a **talk on the life and holiness of the newly canonised Saint John Henry Newman**, in the Cathedral Conference Room at 7 pm on **Thursday next, 14th November**, followed by **Mass of Thanksgiving at 8.15 pm in the Cathedral**. Cardinal Newman has strong connections with Ireland: from 1854 he spent some ten years of his life in Dublin. He founded the Catholic University of Ireland, the precursor of University College Dublin. He also founded a church on St. Stephen's Green, which is there to this day. Famed for his writings, he composed the well-known hymn *Lead Kindly Light*. An Anglican divine, he converted to Catholicism at great personal cost, and had a great influence on English Catholicism, and on theological reflection about important questions such as the proper understanding of a Christian conscience and the vocation of the laity in the Church. A relic of the saint will be present in the Cathedral for veneration. Saint John Henry Newman, Pray for us!
