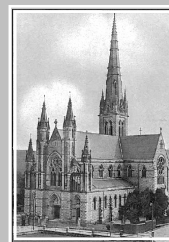

BOXES OF SUNDAY ENVELOPES

The **TAX BACK SCHEME FOR ELIGIBLE CHARITIES** is a tax refund in respect of tax which you have already paid and will remain with Revenue if not claimed by a charity on your behalf. By completing a CHY 3 Certificate, our Parish of Conwal and Leck as an eligible charity **can claim this tax.**

To qualify for this scheme, you must be **SELF-ASSESSED** or a **PAYE only Taxpayer** and have donated €250 to the Parish in a single year either by Sunday Envelope/Standing Order or Donation.

For the majority of our existing Parishioners who have returned CHY 3 Certificates, **a new CERTIFICATE is now required. CHY 3 Forms (with a commencement date of 2019)** are available from the back of the Cathedral. If you have never returned a CHY 3 Form to the Cathedral and wish to do so, please contact the Parochial House on 9121021.
