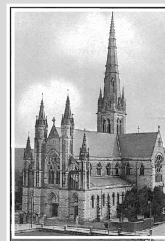

FAREWELL AND SINCERE THANKS TO OUR NET TEAM

This weekend we bid farewell to our NET team. When they came last year, they had to deal with the challenges of Covid, as we all did. They were not daunted. Over the course of their time with us, they have continued their ministry to our teens and young adults online. Perhaps they are better equipped to do this, but it was still a great challenge. They rose to the occasion, and maintained our outreach to our young people very successfully. It has been great for them to meet them in-person when it became possible in a safe manner.

Perhaps as a result of the various lockdowns, the wider parish community became better acquainted with them as a team and individually. It has been really encouraging for them when people came up to them, knowing their names and greeting them warmly. Of course, we have benefitted enormously from their musical generosity, particularly on Sundays and at the Easter Triduum – they were amazing!

We acknowledge how much Anthony Hartnett did to help them in this and in other aspects of their ministry. For the young adults who give a year of their lives to bear witness to their faith to their peers, the year is both a great gift to those young people as they negotiate life in a climate indifferent to faith, but the NET team members also learn and grow in their faith and their abilities in the course of the year; it has been great to see their talents flourish, their faith deepen, and their personalities develop amongst us this year.

The Cathedral 'bubble' will miss them, but will remain deeply grateful for their presence that added so much to our life here, especially during our various lockdowns. Thank you to Peter, Alexandra, Donna, Steffi and to Barnabas who have remained to this point of the year; and to Kevin, Henry, Kayla and Solomon who concluded their time with us earlier this year. We thank our parishioners who supported the Team members in different ways (keeping an eye on their health, on practical things, fundraising, and just welcoming them) and we look forward to our new team next year – they have a great 'act' to follow!

Please note the following guidelines for attending Mass under current Covid-19 restrictions:

- You may come each weekend to your allocated Mass.
- It is not necessary to have a seat allocated for weekday Mass.
- Please leave **10 am Mass** to the elderly and those with underlying conditions.
- Please leave **Friday Evening Masses/Month's Mind Masses/First Anniversary Masses** to the families of the deceased.
- Please follow this simple principle when taking a seat: **TWO PEOPLE PER PEW, OR ONE HOUSEHOLD.**
- Please **observe the two metre rule** when entering the Cathedral, going for Holy Communion or exiting the Cathedral, and at all times both inside and in the grounds of the Cathedral.
- Please wear a mask in the Cathedral unless a medical condition prevents you from doing so. This is for your own protection and out of consideration for those in the Cathedral with you.
- Please **do not attend the Cathedral** if you have a cough, sneezing or any signs of Covid-19.
- **Please sanitise your hands upon entrance and exit.**
- Please **do not** congregate at the doors or in the Cathedral grounds.
- It is **not possible to allow general access** to the Sacristy for the time being. Please arrange Masses through the Parish Office, and arrange to meet with a Priest at the Parochial House

1. **FUNERALS** will take place from Monday - Saturday at 11 am.
2. There will be **NO Sunday Funerals** at the Cathedral for the time being.
3. The congregation should not exceed 50 mourners (**close family and close friends**). Social distancing must be adhered to for entry, exit and seating.
4. All present should wear masks if at all possible.
5. At the graveside, it remains important to maintain the two metre rule.

- ◆ **BAPTISMS** are being celebrated separately for each child: Saturday and Sunday: 2.30 pm and 4 pm. (Times may vary according to our schedule)
- ◆ Presently, Parents, child (children) and two Godparents permitted.
- ◆ Public health guidance requires that there be no unnecessary movement in public settings. Therefore, it will not be possible to have group photography or movement beyond the baptistery. One person should be asked to photograph the ceremony; these can be shared with others present.
