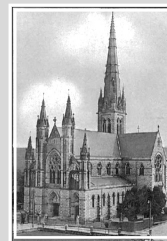

The Ascension of the Lord

YOU ARE INVITED TO OUR PARISH MISSION

We encourage you to take part in our Parish Mission, presented by Holy Family Mission. Although the trauma of the pandemic is becoming a memory (we hope and pray!), still we need to recompose our parish community and find our rhythm again in faith and prayer, individually and as a community. For the early risers, there will be a **Mission Mass at 7.30am (in place of the 8am Mass)**, and a **Mission Mass at 10am**. At these Masses, there will be a short input from the Mission team. During the day, the Mission Team will be in each of our primary schools, and doing visitation in some of the residential areas of town. **Each weekday evening the main Mission liturgy will take place at 7pm:**

Sunday 7pm	HOLY HOUR for Success of the Mission
Monday 7pm	MISSION MASS and Testimony
Tuesday 7pm	MASS WITH ANOINTING OF THE SICK , followed by CANDLELIT PROCESSION WITH THE STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA . This Act of Homage to Our Lady will be our thanksgiving to her under whose protection the parish and the spiritual and physical welfare of its people were placed during the pandemic.
Wednesday 7pm	LITURGY OF RECONCILIATION with INDIVIDUAL Confessions . This evening lies at the heart of our Mission. The peace of God's mercy, our reconciliation to him and to one another is the fount of holiness for us and unlocks the fruits of the Mission and of our faith.
Thursday 7pm	LITURGY OF EUCHARISTIC HEALING . The Holy Eucharist is the food of heaven for us, and the source of all Heaven's gifts and graces; it is the greatest treasure we have. We are called to seek inner healing and peace from Jesus our Eucharistic Lord.
Friday 7pm	MASS WITH AND FOR OUR YOUTH , followed by the YOUTH NIGHT . Our youth – both parishioners and from

Friday 7pm	around the diocese – are called together to be reassured and encouraged in their faith, to find their joy in the Lord and in the company of one another.
Saturday 11am - 4pm	FAMILY DAY. Families are invited to a day of fun activities and moments of reflection. They can come for either session: 11am-1pm, or 2am-4pm. Registration in Trinity Hall [Cathedral Square]. This will be a fun and enjoyable day for families, with elements and activities for parents, young children, teenagers and young adults. From 1pm, individual family blessings with the relics of St. Therese of Lisieux and her parents, Louis and Zélie Martin at the Adoration Chapel. Fun activities & sports at this time in designated locations.
Saturday 6pm	VIGIL OF PENTECOST: This is the culmination of our Mission. During this Mass, a number of adults and young adults will be Baptised, Received into the full communion of the Church or Confirmed, while the congregation will renew their baptismal promises. We will call upon the Holy Spirit to renew each of us personally and the parish as a community.
Pentecost Sunday	The Mission concludes with the RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES at all Masses.
