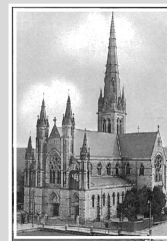

### **THANK YOU TO OUR MISSION TEAM**

A sincere word of thanks and farewell to our Mission Team from Holy Family Mission. In the course of the week, we have come to know Father Patrick Cahill and his gentle, humorous and persuasive presentation of the Gospel, its joys, consolations and calling. The Mission Team presented their own testimony of faith and perseverance as an encouragement to us not to lose heart: they put new heart into us for the living of the faith in a challenging time, reminding us that we are far from alone in bearing witness to Christ.

The Mission team presented a retreat to each of the 6th class groupings in our four National Schools, and visited each of the classrooms to present the mission simply to the children. The Mission Team went to visit a number of the residential areas of the parish with a lot of new housing to reach out a hand of friendship and encounter. They visited some of the elderly and housebound. They met, encouraged and prayed with our youth.

During the course of the week, we were able to reflect on Christian Testimony and the Love of God, on the Healing of God, on the Mercy of God, on the Eucharistic Presence of God, on the Joy of God in our Youth. The Mission reached its culmination in the Solemn Vigil of Pentecost, when by either Baptism or by Reception into Full Communion with the Church, new members joined our Community of Faith, while others completed their Christian Initiation by being Confirmed.

For each person who took part in the Mission, there was a grace. We pray that this grace may grow strong, so that we renew our lives of prayer, our love of the Mass and the Holy Eucharist, and our readiness to be known by the name of Christ. We wish to thank Father Patrick and the whole Mission Team for all they have done for us in terms of encouragement and witness, their lovely singing and happy presence amongst us. May they have many blessings individually and as a group. Sincere thanks to all our marvellous volunteers who helped with ushering the Anointing of the Sick and May Procession on Tuesday, particularly the Knights of Columbanus, the tasty refreshments

afterwards, and the Family Day activities on Saturday. A sincere word of thanks to the Civil Defence for their presence. Thank you to the Sacristans, to all who participated in the music ministry over the week, for all who assisted in the Masses, and for those who prepared the wonderful altar flowers and the flowers around Our Lady's statue on Tuesday.
