THE MASS - THE COLLECT [OPENING PRAYER]

The Gloria, when said on Sundays and Feast Days, is followed by the Collect or Opening Prayer of the Mass. The Collect is a particularly rich and dense prayer. It distils centuries of spiritual and theological insight into the faith.

Many of the Collects are of great antiquity, dating from the first millennium and used in the Church for well over a thousand years. Others are of more recent composition, but draw on material used anciently.

It is worthwhile paying attention to these prayers, especially when printed in leaflets etc. for the benefit of the people. They can profitably be used throughout the week in one's own prayer.

The Collect is introduced by the celebrant with the invitation to prayer: "Let us pray", followed by a brief pause for silence. This invitation shows the nature of this prayer and its name – the "Collect": it gathers together the prayer of the entire assembly, and indeed in a sense of the whole Church.

The Mass is an action of the whole Church throughout the world, of the Church already gathered into the heavenly realm and of the souls in Purgatory; the Mass is never only a prayer of the particular priest, of the particular congregation or parish, but an action of the whole mystery of the Church.

Being invited to pray, we pray certainly on our own behalf and with the intention that we carry with us, but we also carry the prayer of the whole Church.

The silent pause that follows the invitation to pray reminds us that silence is the privileged space in which the Holy Spirit wishes to work, bringing us into the peace that belongs to God. **LETTERKENNY MEMORIES** will take place on Monday 24th April at 8 pm in the Station House Hotel.
