

The Mass – The Liturgy of the Word Sunday Cycle of Readings – Ordinary Time

The readings at Mass follow a number of cycles. There is one cycle for Sundays organised over three years, and one for weekdays, organised over two years. Then there are special readings set out for the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter. Feast days have special readings, and various sacramental celebrations have specific readings selected.

The Sunday cycle of readings is known as Years A, B and C. During the Sundays of Year A, the Gospel of Saint Matthew is read; during the Sundays of Year B, the Gospel of Saint Mark; and during the Sundays of Year C, the Gospel of Saint Luke. Sometimes extracts from the Gospel of Saint John supplement these readings, particularly during Year B since the Gospel of Saint Mark is shorter than the others. Otherwise the Gospel of Saint John is favoured for the seasons of Christmas and Easter.

Typically, the First Reading of a Sunday is chosen from the Old Testament to reflect the Gospel passage; therefore, there is a clear connection between the First Reading and the Gospel. For instance, this Sunday, the first reading is from Isaiah and reflects on the fruitfulness of the word of God compared to the rain – it does not return to the heavens without succeeding in what it was meant to do; the Psalm (Ps. 64) is the beautiful hymn of praise that acknowledges God's bounty in the fruitfulness of the seasons; these resonate with the Gospel, in which Jesus recounts the Parable of the Sower and how the soil of our souls receives the seed of the Word.

The Second Reading is chosen from the Acts of the Apostles [particularly during Eastertide], the letters of Saint Paul, Saint Peter, Saint John, Saint James, Hebrews and the Apocalypse. These New Testament Epistles are read systematically on Sundays over a three year period.

Therefore, over three years, the People of God have an opportunity to read the Gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke, and large portions of the Gospel of Saint

John, the principal extracts of the Old Testament, and the Epistles and Acts of the Apostles of the New Testament. This was a desire of the Fathers of the Second Vatican Council in reforming the Liturgy, namely that the riches of the Scriptures would be opened more widely to the Faithful.

After the 12 noon Mass today, **Sunday 16th July**, the **BROWN SCAPULAR** of **Our Lady of Mount Carmel** will be blessed and imposed.
