

THE MASS – THE LITURGY OF THE WORD Sunday Cycle of Readings – Ordinary Time

The readings at Mass follow a number of cycles. We have seen the Sunday Cycle, but there is also a Weekday Cycle over two years. In the Weekday Cycle, there is no direct correlation between the First Reading and Psalm and the Gospel. The First Readings take us through a wide selection of the books of the Old and New Testament. They present the central extracts and the great episodes from the history of the Old Testament from Abraham through Moses, David, the Prophets, the Kings, and the wisdom writings. The books of the New Testament are presented almost completely, particularly during the Easter Season. The Psalm of the day correlates to the reading. The Gospel readings bring us through the three Gospels of Mathew, Mark and Luke, supplemented by the Gospel of John during the Ordinary Time of the year. This cycle of readings exposes us to the tremendous richness of the Scriptures, and provides an opportunity to reflect on God's dealing with his people, the history of salvation, reflection on human nature and our capacity for sin and for grace, and words of tremendous consolation and guidance.
