

# THE MASS – THE LITURGY OF THE WORD CYCLE OF READINGS FOR THE SEASONS

The seasons of **Advent, Christmas, Lent** and **Easter** each have their own cycle of readings. These are chosen to present and reflect on the mysteries of the Incarnation and the Paschal Mystery of Our Lord's suffering, death and resurrection.

The readings for the season of **Advent** follow two points of emphasis. The readings of the first part of Advent directs our thoughts to the second coming of Christ at the end of time, while the second part of Advent directs our thoughts to his first coming, his birth, and the mystery of our redemption. This is particularly evident for the Sunday readings.

The first Sunday calls us to attention, to "stay awake" until the Lord's coming; on the Second Sunday we encounter John the Baptist calling us to repentance; on the third John the Baptist pointing out the true nature of Christ; and on the fourth we read an account of the angelic visitation to Mary or to Joseph.

The weekday cycle for Advent draws from the rich texts of the Old Testament that speak of the Lord's coming, of expectation, conversion and preparation. These readings as a cycle are amongst the most beautiful for the whole liturgical year.

The Gospel readings on the weekdays of Advent follow the same pattern, the first part of Advent drawing from the Lord's teaching concerning the expectation of the Redeemer of Israel in the Scriptures, who he reveals himself to be, while nearer Christmas speaks more of his mission and the purpose of his coming for our salvation. From 17th - 24th December, the readings and prayers are specially chosen for this octave of preparation for the feast of the Lord's birth.

This is to help us better listen to God's word and be more attentive to His voice. Our busy everyday lives are often very distracted and noisy.
