

# The Mass – The Liturgy of the Word Cycle of Readings for the Seasons: Christmastide

It seems odd to turn our attention to the season of Christ's birth as we continue our journey through the Mass. Following on from what we said about the Liturgy of the Word in the Season of Advent, Christmastide runs from the Vigil Mass of the Nativity of the Lord through to the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which functions as a conclusion to the season of Christmas and an opening to the period between seasons, known as 'Ordinary Time' or 'Time Through the Year'. The cycle of readings for Christmastide leans heavily and unsurprisingly on the writings of Saint John, both for the First Readings on the weekday cycle and the Second Readings of the Sundays and Feastdays of Christmastide. In fact, this short season is filled with feastdays: St. Stephen, the Holy Innocents, St. John the Evangelist, the Motherhood of Mary, the Holy Family, the Epiphany.

As Christmas was prepared for by an octave (17th - 24th), so it is followed by an Octave 25th December – 1st January, concluding with the great feast of the Mary, Mother of God, or the Motherhood of Mary. The readings in this period, both weekdays, feastdays and Sundays, reflect on the great mystery of the Incarnation, the wonder of the Redemption won for us in Jesus Christ, and the mystery of Mary's part in the divine plan, and ours. The Epiphany readings draw out the three moments of the revelation of Jesus Christ as Son of God and Saviour: the Adoration of the Magi, his Baptism in the Jordan, and his first miracle at Cana in Galilee when "he let his glory be seen and his disciples believed in him" (Jn 2:11).

Blessed St. Clare, you trusted in the Blessed Sacrament as your only protection. In your hour of need you heard a voice from the Sacred Host: "I will always take care of you". We entrust our needs to you, especially . . . (mention request). Enkindle in us a tender love for Jesus and Mary. Help us to trust Him as you did. Intercede for our families, our friends, our youth and all those who need our prayers. We pray for our Church, our country and our suffering world. Amen. (St. Clare's Feast Day: 11th August)
