The Mass: The Liturgy of the Word for the Easter Triduum

The Readings set out for the Easter Triduum—Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday—do not vary from year to year. This series of readings is a powerful reflection on the central mysteries of our faith. The Mass of Chrism, usually celebrated on Holy Thursday morning, is the Mass during which the oils to be used in the sacraments during the year throughout the diocese are blessed by the Bishop. It is also at this Mass that the priests renew the promises of their ordination. Therefore, the readings reflect the theme of anointing, pointing us to reflect on the anointing of Jesus as the Christ [the Anointed One] by the Holy Spirit, the anointing of baptism and the anointing of priesthood. Baptism and Priesthood represent two fulcrums of the life of the Church. Therefore, the first reading of the Mass of Chrism is from the prophet Isaiah (The Spirit of the Lord has been given to be, for the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor). Psalm 88 refers to the anointing of King David and the roles of priest, prophet and king which will be fulfilled in Jesus (I have fund David my servant, and with my holy oil I have anointed him). The second reading is from the Apocalypse and presents the fulfilment of the Lord's mission at the end of time. He is the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end—words that will be taken up in the blessing of the Paschal Candle at the beginning of the Easter Vigil, a symbol of the Lord risen from the dead, scattering the darkness of sin from the light of grace. The Gospel, from St. Luke, presents Jesus preaching in the synagogue of Nazareth at the beginning of his public ministry. He quotes from the prophet Isaiah the very passage read in the first reading (The Spirit of the Lord has been given to me), and says: "This text is being fulfilled today even as you listen". Each of these readings leads us to reflect both on the saving ministry of Jesus, and on our own participation in it by baptism and by priestly ordination.



Prayer for the Canonisation of Blessed Carlo Acutis

O God, Our Father, thank you for giving us Carlo, a life example for the young, and a message of love for everyone. You made him become enamoured with Your Son Jesus, making of the Eucharist his "highway to heaven". You gave him Mary, as a most loving Mother, and with the Rosary, you made him a poet of tenderness. Receive his prayer for us. Above all, gaze upon the poor, whom he loved and helped. Grant for

me too, by his intercession the grace that I need (..) and make our joy fulfilled, placing Carlo among the Saints of your Church, so that his smile may shine again for us in the glory of your name. Amen. (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory be to the Father)
