### A BLESSING FOR THE YEAR TO COME

The New Year is a 'liminal' moment, a moment of crossing, of change, of looking back and of facing forward. We can easily be caught in one or the other, continuously looking back and trapped by what we should learn to leave behind and, in Christian terms, entrust to God's mercy. Or we can be continuously running ahead, either in escape or unreflective haste. At times it is easy to be trapped by indecision, having neither the courage to look at our actions frankly and honestly, or to embrace the challenge that stands before us, to go into the unknown.

For us who walk the path of life with Christian faith, God's grace enters in.
