

ST. BRIGIDS CROSS MAKING

On Thursday 1st February, we will celebrate the Feast Day of Ireland's secondary Patron Saint, namely St. Brigid, affectionately known as Mary of the Gael (Muire na nGael), who was renowned for her deep faith, warm hospitality, and care of the sick. Inspired by these saintly qualities, the beautiful custom arose, that was passed down through the generations, of families, neighbours,



friends, and communities, gathering together on the eve of her Feast Day (31st January), to make the traditional St. Brigid's Cross. This Cross with either three or four arms, and a woven pattern in the centre, is used to invoke God's blessing and protection.

On the eve of St. Brigid's Day, 31st January, you are most warmly invited to come along to join in the making of St. Brigid's Crosses and to keep the flame of this beautiful tradition alight at 6 pm and again at 8 pm, in the Divine Mercy Centre.
