

Blessing of the Members of the Parish Pastoral Council 2023 - 2026

At 12 noon Mass today the new members of the Parish Pastoral Council will be blessed. We take the opportunity to thank those that served on the previous Council until the pandemic disrupted the rhythm of meetings and parish activity. The renewal of the Parish Council reflects the call issued by Bishop McGuckian for parishioners throughout the diocese to take up the challenge of 'co-responsibility' for the life of their parish and of the wider Church. It is part of the Pastoral Plan *Ar Aghaidh le Chéile*. It is rooted in the calling of baptism, by which we are all brothers and sisters of Christ who make up his body, the Church. While the priest makes the apostolic ministry present in each local community, and is therefore a "fellow-worker" with the Bishop, each member of the faithful must have an awareness of their responsibility for passing on the faith and building up the community of faith.

Over a year ago, an invitation was issued for parishioners to attend an initial meeting on Parish Pastoral Councils. Over a hundred people from the various parishes of the local deaneries attended. After a series of three meetings, those who were interested to continue on a journey of formation were invited to attend a further series of monthly meetings. It is from this process that the new members of the Pastoral Council have emerged. Today they are being both presented and blessed. The role of the Pastoral Council is to assist the priest to encourage and direct the pastoral activity of the parish for the good of souls. It is to be a body that is rooted in prayer and the Scripture, nourished by the Church's teaching, by the sacraments and the parish community. From this prayerful and reflective group, we trust that many good things will come about for the good of the parish, making it a place of witness, welcome and spiritual wellbeing, to the praise and honour of God.
