

## The Day of Resurrection: Journey to the Father

Journeys are often significant for our life. We were carried in our mother's womb as loved ones and friends rejoiced at the promise of life that we, by God's providence, turned out to be. By God's gift of health, we stood up and took our first steps. We have taken steps into life, decisions, and relationships. At a certain point, we came have come to observe that, although we think we are taking the initiative, boldly stepping out as we determine and decide, in fact often we are carried along – sometimes by circumstance, sometimes by the bearing of others on our life's journey, sometimes simply in confusion or unawareness as the currents move beneath us and carry us along.

Jesus too walked this path of our experience. On Palm Sunday he was carried along in triumph; on Good Friday in derision. He seemed almost passive as cloaks and palms were spread beneath him.

Today, however, Jesus takes up his life as he lay it down. He, the eternal and unseen God, the Word through whom all things came into be and by whose Spirit all things are held in being, entered into the journey by which he emptied himself into the Virgin's womb, walked in our shoes and entered into the mystery of suffering and death, indeed into the mystery of sin, although he is without sin. He was not robbed of the Spirit but freely gave it forth, pouring out his peace on the world [cf. John 19:30; John 14:27]. He is the one alone who has the power to lay down his life in sacrifice for us and to take it up again [cf. John 10:18-19].

Today Jesus takes up his life. He shows himself to be the only protagonist of life and death; he alone is an agent in the journey of life. He calls us to be 'protagonists' of this life he has given to us, making our way to the Father, through the portal of the cross and into the resurrection. This is the meaning of the baptismal journey and life: to join ourselves to Christ in his journey to the Father by continuously dying to sin and rising to new life.
